“Lumbee Traditional Elders Use of The Lumbee Culture Center”

Whereas, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina ,a recognized Tribe of the State of North Carolina Subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and its inherent powers of self-government; and

Whereas, Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council; and

Whereas, The Tribal Council has the authority and fiduciary responsibility to ensure compliance with all programs, funding, and allocations; and

Whereas, The Tribal Council appropriates funds for the Lumbee Culture Center; and

Whereas, The Lumbee Traditional Elders have been conducting Spiritual and Religious Worship Services/Ceremonies at what is commonly known as the Elders Area of the Culture Center; and Lumbee Traditional Elders Worship and Ceremony Area; and

Whereas, The Lumbee Traditional Elders have kept and maintained our traditional sacred fire within the Elders Area of the Culture Center; and

Whereas, The Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina provides no protections for the Ceremonious and Religious Rights and Freedoms of its people, it is deemed this action is necessary;

Therefore, Be it enacted the Lumbee Traditional Elders Worship and Ceremony Area will be accessible to the Lumbee Traditional Elders for the purposes of exercising our Traditional Ceremonies and Religious Rights and Freedoms of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina with the exception of natural disasters or major construction in that specified area; and

Therefore, Be it further enacted the Lumbee Traditional Elders Worship and Ceremony Area, with the exception normal land upkeep maintenance, shall not be altered without the consultation, and approval of Lumbee Traditional Elders; and

Therefore, Be it finally enacted that the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina embraces, and holds in the highest regards the sanctity and sacredness of the Lumbee Traditional Elders Worship and Ceremony Area whose geographical location is within the Lumbee Culture Center which encompasses our sacred fire, and as such will forever be protected as a sacred site by the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina.


