“To Establish Sweat Lodge Ceremonies at The Lumbee Tribal Cultural Center.”

WHEREAS, The Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina, a recognized Tribe of the State of North Carolina Subject to the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and its inherent powers of self-government; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina delegates all legislative authority to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has the authority and fiduciary responsibility to ensure compliance with all programs funding and allocation; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council appropriates funds for the Lumbee Tribe Culture Center; and

WHEREAS, Members of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina have participated and continue to participate in Sweat Lodge Ceremonies as part of their inherent ceremony and religious rights; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina provides no protections for the Ceremonious and Religious Rights and Freedoms of its people, it is deemed this action is necessary;

THEREFORE, Be it enacted the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina shall construct a non-ceremonial living museum Sweat Lodge in the vicinity of the LongHouse and Wigwam to educate Lumbee tribal members as well as the general public on the Sweat Lodge Ceremony practices at The Lumbee Tribe Culture Center; and


THEREFORE, Be it further enacted the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina shall allow the continuous practice of Sweat Lodge Ceremonies in designated areas of the Lumbee Tribe Cultural Center for the purposes of exercising our Traditional Ceremonies and Religious Rights and Freedoms of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina; and

THEREFORE, Be it further enacted the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina shall create Sweat Lodge buildings in designated areas of The Lumbee Tribe Cultural Center and no limitation to access for ceremony with the exception of natural disaster and/or major construction on the grounds of The Lumbee Tribe Cultural Center.




